#### Urban Ecological Restoration Course

- Target group: city and government managers, academic experts, consultants, NGOs, research institutes and contractors
- Dates: 31 August – 5 September 2009 (1 week)
- Venue: IUTC, Gangwon Province, Korea
- Deadline for application: 19 July 2009
- Objective/feature: develop capacity of integrated restoration planning and implementation in urban environments with understanding on ecological restoration function and value as strategic solution to sustainable urbanization and climate change

  - [Module 2] Ecological restoration planning and practice
  - [Module 3] Ecological water function restoration
